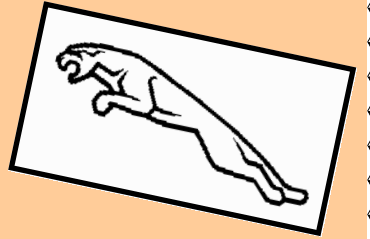

Santa Cruz Mountain Tour & Pot Luck

Start Time: 10:00 a.m., Saturday, July 8th

(Limited to the first 25 cars making reservations)

It's time to plan ahead and make sure you get to enjoy one of the highlights of the summer. Mark the calendar – don't forget to make the reservation either. This year, **Dana & Janet Brown** are your tour planners and guides, and they promise an exciting and pleasurable tour – maybe a winery you have never visited! Just make sure your Jaguar is up to the rigors of the mountains and is as interested as you are in seeing new places and enjoying the camaraderie of other Jaguar lovers.

The day's activities will start from the Baker Square Restaurant at the corner of University Ave. & Highway 9 in Los Gatos. The starting time will be a leisurely (for those in the South Bay) 10:00 a.m. Incidentally Baker's Square serves a very good breakfast from an extensive menu so don't hesitate to come early and have a hearty breakfast so you have ample energy to pilot the Jaguar over some very challenging roads.

Arrival time at the Santa Cruz Mountain home of **Dick & Norma France** is estimated to be around 1:30 or 2:00 p.m. There we will partake of the potluck food complemented by beer, wine, soda, chips, bread, etc.

Each couple should bring a potluck salad, or entrée, or dessert that will serve eight. You can indicate what you are going to bring on the reservation form and send it in, or you can give Norma a call at 408-353-3770 and discuss the situation. In addition to the potluck dish there is a charge of **\$5.00 per person** to cover the cost of refreshments and incidentals. If it is not possible to bring a "Potluck" item you are still more than welcome, but the cost rises from \$5.00 per person **to \$10.00 per person**. If your potluck item would be better if it did not accompany your Jaguar on the tour with Dana & Janet, Dick will be at Baker's Square to collect the food and transport it directly to the mountain, where refrigeration and/or ovens or table areas will be available.

Directions to Baker Square Restaurant:

From everywhere but Santa Cruz and the Coast: Take Highways 680, 280, 101, 85 or whatever and get onto Highway 17 heading toward Los Gatos/Santa Cruz. Exit highway 17 at Los Gatos, Saratoga, Highway 9 Exit. Immediately get in the left lane and at the first traffic light turn left onto University Ave. and immediately turn right into the parking lot behind Bakers Square Restaurant. Go straight through the restaurant parking lot to the larger public parking lot and meeting place.

From Santa Cruz and the Coast: Take Highway 17 toward San Jose and exit at the Los Gatos, Saratoga, Highway 9 Exit and go back over Highway 17 and at the first traffic light turn left onto University Ave and follow above directions.
