Judging: Judging will be in accordance with Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) practices.

First in Class winners from 2007 will not be eligible for class judging in 2008. However those winners are encouraged to return for display, special recognition and overall award consideration.

The Concours committee invites Concours entrants to experience the 8th annual Hillsborough Tour d'Elegance where "The Drive is Half the Fun" on Saturday morning, May 3rd. The two to three hour tour leads drivers along some of our area's most scenic byways. Luncheon follows.
