that relate to JCNA Bylaws and procedure that remain unclear to some Board members.

Treasurer Mantha's report comprising an updated Profit & Loss statement and estimate for the calendar year 2009 projecting a net operating loss of about \$4,800 for the year. The club's checking account balance on Oct. 6 was \$7,233, including \$5,000 drawn from the reserve account at the end of 2008. The Board debated the issue of membership dues again and after punting once, then unanimously approved a recommendation for a dues increase of \$10 for 2010. Director France was tapped to justify this recommendation to the membership in this issue of the JAGazette and solicit approval when the issue appears on the 2009 ballot.

Editor France reported his contentment with the October issue of the JAGazette and received commendations from Smith and Edwards. The prospect of combining the December and January issues to save money was discussed and tacitly approved.

Vice-Presidents Sis Stein and Lew Edwards reported ongoing arrangements of club events through June 2010. As usual, the Christmas party is budgeted to incur a loss and a subsidy up to \$1000 from club funds was approved at the June meeting. The unrelenting burden of sustaining monthly events and co-ordinating with the Editor of the JAGazette tends to be taken for granted by the rest of the Board and more so by the membership.

Incoming Membership chair Dave Klabunde reported by e-mail receipt of two new members' dues and one seasoned member's change of address. Thus total membership on 10/5/09 stood at 282, including 14 new members joining to date in 2009.

President Smith offered his help in urging other clubs in JCNA's Southwest Region to support Jerry Nuijen's candidacy for JCNA Regional Director. JAG' members' favorable votes should be of particular help as JAG is the largest club in the Region.

The next Board meeting will be scheduled in January 2010 in Los Gatos at the home of Dick and Norma France.


