When the Tiburon Classic show features Jaguars, some nice ones show up. And many of them are owned by locals who live so close to the show that they can be rolled in to park without starting the engines!

Tom O'Neill was smart to pick this part of June for the show. It always seems to be a glorious Sunday when you look out to Angel Island, the city and the Golden Gate. And what a pleasure when you turn around and look towards the cars parked on Paradise Drive.

I was pleased to see that all the Jaguars were staged at the opening end of the show where viewers entered. The first car was Dave Olson's Aluminum race XK 120 right next to Skip Berg's 1951 120 LTI in a shiny black. Not far away was the Mal-lya Collection's 1954 D type short nose with its 285 hp 3.4 litre engine. Add to this a 1953 Heritage C type. Tom Price's 1948 Mark IV was an eye catcher in silver and black. Right next to it was Steve Silen's 1959 Mark IX sedan. I was then right in front of Ken Metzgar's 1954 cream white XK 120 M

I was not surprised to see that there was no E type that could touch Stephen Cross's recently restored '65 Series I. The color is opalescent with red interior. With the hood up, the big 4.2 engine was visible in all its polished glory.

As there were 100 cars in the show, I will only mention one non Jaguar as she fit so nicely into the look of the big cats. It was Robert Cory's 1937 De Lahaye Roadster.

Some owners were perched on show chairs with their back turned to the bay. Others were under little tents. All shared one thing in common: a lot of pride in their cars.

Tom proposed to carry the show well into the evening by offering a certain number of cars the chance to park on the main street in Tiburon from five to nine p.m.; a perfect chance for owners to pick their favorite restaurant while keeping one eye on their car. And what an opportunity for tourists with cameras as they exit from dining.

This is a show that should always be on your calendar.
