Drive to Lake Tahoe
With Bodacious BBQ Dinner

Cut-off Date is Friday, August 13**

Once again, it's time to make plans to join your fellow JAG travelers on our tour to "The Lake." Our esteemed President was so pleased with last year's trip that he suggested we follow the same scenic route – so, we will! Give your cat a great run starting at Marie Callendars in Walnut Creek, up through the Sacramento valley to Oroville and on up the Feather River Canyon with Lunch at "Scooters Café" aka the Bikers Hangout. (Those who've joined us in the past may remember this very friendly biker bar with surprisingly good food and both Indoor and Outdoor seating.) Then we'll journey on to Quincy, Graeagle and Truckee, to check into our motels and freshen up.

Dinner will be served at Dave and Sue Klabunde's home in Tahoe Donner where hospitality abounds with adult beverages, Beef from the Binford 4000 Grill, various accoutrements, dessert and great conversation next to a rushing waterfall. All this for just \$25 per person. What an evening!

Unfortunately last year, six persons dropped out unannounced. So this year Prepayment will be required – No Exceptions. The Reservation form is on page 3 and must be received one week ahead so provisions can be obtained. Cut-off Date is Friday, August 13th. Last year we had a marvelous turnout of 39 JAG members and friends which actually put us at capacity. So this year we hope to have a large group which will be limited to 39-40 persons.

Meeting time is 8:45 AM with a Departure time of 9:15 AM from the parking lot of Marie Callendars in Walnut Creek at the corner of Mt Diablo Blvd and California Blvd. You may want to start off with breakfast at Marie Callendars.

Directions to Starting Point: From the south – take Hwy 680 north to the Olympic Blvd off ramp in Walnut Creek. Turn right at the light and continue 1 ½ blocks. Turn left and you are in the Marie Callendars' parking lot.

From the west – take Hwy 24 east. At the Y in Walnut Creek, bear right as if going toward San Jose on Hwy. 680, but keep a sharp eye out for the Mt Diablo Blvd off ramp immediately to your left which you should take. At the stop light at the base of the off ramp, proceed east on Mt. Diablo Blvd. to California Blvd. (2nd stop light ahead) and turn right into the Marie Callendars' parking lot. Note: You will see a Marie Callendar's restaurant and Genova Deli.

From the north – take Hwy 680 south and exit onto the Olympic Blvd off ramp. At the base of the off ramp, turn left and go east under the freeway. Go 1 ½ blocks and you will see CVS Pharmacy, Genova Deli and Marie Callendars' on your left.

After we reach our motels in Truckee, there'll be time to clean up and wash off that trail dust before joining Dave & Sue Klabunde at their home deep in the pines for a wonderful dinner. See below for recommended motels in the Truckee area.

Come Sunday morning, plan for a brunch alongside Lake Tahoe or in Truckee – if you wish. More info on local favorites will be handed out when at dinner.
